Welcome to Wonder Camp!

To help you and your camper(s) prepare for their “wonder”ful camp experience, please read through the following information carefully. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us by phone or email.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Camp programming runs from 9:00am - 4:00pm. You can drop off your camper(s) between 8:45am - 9:00am, and pick them up between 4:00pm - 4:15pm.

Parents/guardians are required to sign camper(s) in and out of each camp day before they will be permitted to enter or leave the camp space.

As part of your camp registration, you listed the names of any additional people authorized to pick up your camper(s). Campers will only be released to names on that list. If someone else will be picking up your child, please let the Camp Leaders know in the morning at drop off so that person can be added to the list. Only the main contact on the registration form may add or remove names to the authorized pick up list.

Drop-offs and Pick-ups During the Camp Day

If you need to drop off your camper(s) after 9:00am or pick up your camper(s) prior to 4:00pm, please let us know as soon as possible so we can be prepared to meet you.

Missing a Day

If your child will be absent for a camp day, please let us know as soon as possible.

Late Fees

A late fee will be charged for any campers who are picked up late. The following fees apply:

- For pick ups up to 15 minutes late, a \$10 charge will be added
- For each minute past the first 15 minutes, a \$1 charge will be added

Activities

Wonder Camps feature several activities throughout the day supervised by our Camp Leaders. Some examples of the activities that may occur include, but are not limited to:

Outdoor Exploration

- During most camps, campers will head outside, weather permitting, to play and explore at Nutrien Playland, located in Kinsmen Park, go on a nature walk down the Meewasin Trail, or to play some games and build in the open green space beside Wonderhub
- Campers are expected to go outside during light rain or snow, and if the temperature falls between -26°C and +30°C (windchill or humidex inclusive)
- During air quality warnings or notices from Environment Canada, outdoor time will either be reduced or shifted to indoor activities to protect the health of campers and staff.

STEAM Based Activities or Projects

- Many of the activities or projects campers will participate in during the day have elements of Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math in varying and age-appropriate degrees
- This may include designing and building something out of blocks, experiencing science experiments, creating with a variety of craft supplies and materials, and more
- Movement & Socialization Games
- Campers will spend time playing in both organized and freestyle ways to encourage movement and socialization

Storytimes

- Campers will have the opportunity to listen to stories to inspire their activities and creations

Other Activities

- And of course, camper(s) will have plenty of time each day to explore each of the galleries in Wonderhub in smaller groups!

What to Bring

🌿 Lunch and Snacks

- Please pack your camper(s) a lunch with enough for 2 snack breaks. There is no access to a fridge or microwave.
- Please do not pack any food that may contain nuts

🌿 Appropriate Clothing

- Campers will have the chance to discover, create, explore, learn, and play and sometimes this can get messy! Please wear play-appropriate clothing that can stand to get a little messy.
- For our **Summer** Wonder Camps, campers should also bring a set of swim clothes and a towel in a separate bag labelled with the camper's name as they will have the opportunity to cool down in the spray park across the street
- **Socks** are mandatory. Wonderhub requires all guests to wear socks in our museum exhibits, including camp spaces. Shoes are not permitted unless they are a clean, indoor only pair.

🌿 Prep for the Weather

- During our outdoor exploration time, all campers are expected to head out as a group, and should come prepared for the weather each day. In the colder months, this includes winter boots, ski pants, jacket, mitts, toque, scarf. In the warmer months, this includes a hat, running shoes, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug spray.
- Please apply **sunscreen and bug spray** prior to arriving at camp. If you send extra sunscreen and bug spray with your child, please tell them to ask for help from a leader before reapplying.

🌿 Personal Items

- Campers should not bring any personal items such as toys, cell phones, games, smart watches, or money to camp
- Staff are not responsible for the loss or damage of items brought to camp

🌿 Lost and Found

- Any items found after camp has ended will be placed in Wonderhub's lost and found. This is located in the Gift Shop off of the main lobby and can be accessed during Wonderhub's regular operating hours



Health and Medical Information

- All campers must be able to use the bathroom independently
- If a child becomes ill while at camp, they will be moved to a separate space, their belongings and take-home creations will be gathered with them, and a phone call to their parent/guardian will be made requiring immediate pick up from camp.
- For campers with allergies that require an Epi-Pen, or asthma requiring an inhaler, please ensure this is indicated on your registration form. At drop-off, please indicate to staff where the Epi-Pen or inhaler is located. Epi-pens and inhalers will accompany the campers in the museum and outdoors. Medication must be clearly labelled with the child's first and last name.
- If your child requires medication, it should be administered prior to camp when possible. If it must be taken during the camp day, please contact us ahead of time to discuss.

Camp Etiquette and Expectations

At Wonderhub, we emphasize being kind to ourselves, others, and the environment, including the museum exhibits. It is important that all our campers, staff, and volunteers feel welcome, safe, and engaged. Wonderhub is a space to come together, celebrate community, and learn through play. We foster a sense of care and respect for others through facilitating safe, positive behaviours, and age-appropriate conflict resolution. Camp leaders strive to lead by example with positive words, actions and reinforcing positive behaviours.

At Wonderhub, we prioritize the safety and well-being of all children, staff, volunteers, and visitors. Unsafe behaviors are those that put anyone at risk of harm. This can include actions such as running away from the group, hiding, using hurtful words or actions towards others, causing deliberate harm to another person, or damaging property, whether it be Wonderhub's or personal belongings. Any unsafe behavior will be addressed and redirected immediately.

If a child's behavior threatens their own safety or the safety of others, Wonderhub may ask the child to go home for the day to ensure everyone's well-being.

In the event that a camper must be removed from camp due to behaviour, you as the parent/guardian are obligated to pick your camper up from camp promptly. Any damage to property will be paid for by the parent/guardian. No refund will be issued for campers asked to leave due to behaviour.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- A 50% refund will be provided for cancellations submitted less than 2 weeks before the first day of camp
- No refund will be provided for cancellations submitted less than 7 days before the first day of camp
- All refunds are subject to one of the following administration fees:
 - \$20 for a single day Wonder Camp
 - \$60 for 3-day Wonder Camp
 - \$75 for a 4 or 5-day Wonder Camp
- Cancellation requests should be submitted to programming@wonderhub.ca and must include the child(ren)'s full name and camp date(s) requested.
