Discovery Visits: Self-guided exploration PLUS a facilitated program

When you arrive at the museum, gather your group in the lobby and one of our Education Facilitators will meet your group. If your class is in the AM1 or PM1 time slot, we will lead your class to the Classroom for the **45 minute facilitation time**, which will be followed by time for you and your small groups to explore the museum. If your class is in the AM2 or PM2 time slot, we will direct you into the museum for the **70 minute exploration time**, which will be followed by your facilitated program. At the end of your visit, all students and chaperones will gather in the lower lobby to prepare for departure. Chaperones are required at a ratio of **1 adult per 6 children**.

Exploration Visits: Self-guided exploration

When you arrive at the museum, gather your group in the lobby before entering the museum. Once your group is together, the contact person can check-in at the admission desk to pay, and you may enter the museum as a group. This visit **does not have a facilitated portion**. Once your large group has entered the museum, you and your small groups are welcome to play, explore, create and engage with all that Nutrien Wonderhub has to offer. Chaperones are required at a ratio of **1 adult per 6 children**.

What to bring

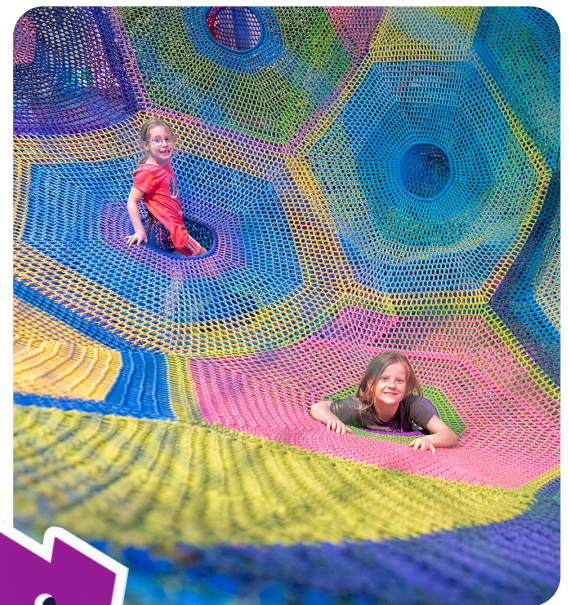
- **Bring socks:** we are a shoe-free, socks required facility. If someone forgets socks, fun grip socks are available for purchase for \$4+tax.
- **Water bottle and snacks!** Snacks and lunches can be enjoyed in our lower lobby area for large groups and in our cafe area for small groups. Water bottle filling stations are available around the museum. We have a grab and go in the gift shop to purchase beverages and snacks.
- **Personal items:** we suggest leaving all personal items, electronics, and valuables at home. Should you require, lockers are available to use across from the admissions desk.

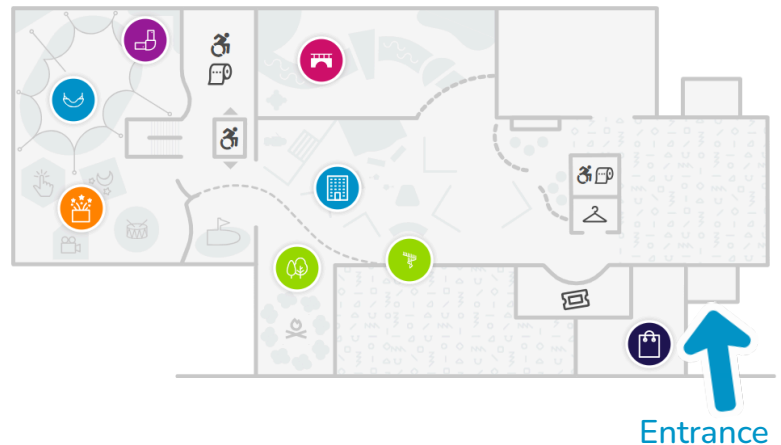

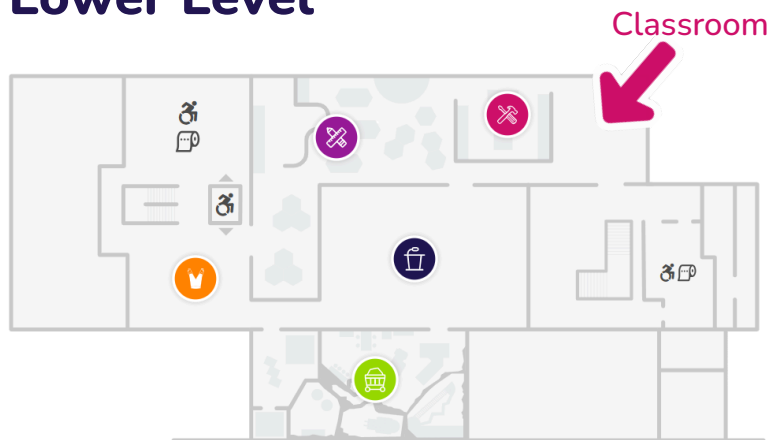
