



Wonder Camps: Mini Discoveries Information Guide

Welcome to Wonder Camp!

Drop-off and Pick-up

Mini Discoveries programming for ages 3-5 runs from 9:00am - 11:45am OR 1:00pm - 3:45pm. For morning camps you can drop off your camper(s) between 8:45am - 9:00am and pick them up between 11:45am - 12:00pm. For afternoon camps you can drop off your camper(s) between 12:45 - 1:00pm, and pick them up between 3:45 - 4:00pm.

Parents/guardians are required to sign camper(s) in and out of each camp day before they will be permitted to enter or leave the camp space.

As part of your camp registration, you listed the names of any additional people authorized to pick up your camper(s). Campers will only be released to names on that list. If someone else will be picking up your child, please let the Camp Leaders know in the morning at drop off so that person can be added to the list. Only the main contact on the registration form may add or remove names to the authorized pick up list.

Drop-offs and Pick-ups During the Camp Day

If you need to drop off your camper(s) outside of the pick-up and drop-off times, please let us know as soon as possible so we can be prepared to meet you.

Missing a Day

If your child will be absent for a camp day, please let us know as soon as possible.

Late Fees

A late fee will be charged for any campers who are picked up late. The following fees apply:

For pick ups up to 15 minutes late, a \$10 charge will be added

For each minute past the first 15 minutes, a \$1 charge will be added

What will campers do?

This is a half-day, play-based camp designed especially for curious 3–5-year-olds. Rooted in the power of open-ended play, this camp invites children to explore, imagine, and create in the unique and inspiring spaces of Nutrien Wonderhub, indoors and out. These four-day camps are thoughtfully designed with the developmental needs of this age group in mind. With a 1:6 leader-to-camper ratio, children will enjoy unstructured museum and outdoor play, along with built-in time for snacks and movement—all at their own pace and through the magic of play!

Sample Schedule:

- **8:45- 9:00am - Drop-off** inside Wonderhub.
- **9:00-9:15am Soft Landing and Morning Greeting** – Children will participate in playful activities designed to gently welcome them to the space and camp day
- **9:15-10:45am Museum Exploration**
- **10:45-11:15 Snack and Storytime**
- **11:15-11:45am Outdoor Play and Exploration**
- **11:45-12:00pm Pick-up** outside Wonderhub in front of the conservatory

Outdoor Exploration

During most camps, campers will head outside, weather permitting, to play and explore at Nutrien Playland, located in Kinsmen Park, go on a nature walk down the Meewasin Trail, or to play some games and build in the open green space beside Wonderhub.

Campers are expected to go outside during light rain or snow, and if the temperature falls between -26°C and +30°C (windchill or humidex inclusive).

During air quality warnings or notices from Environment Canada, outdoor time will either be reduced or shifted to indoor activities to protect the health of campers and staff.

What to Bring

● Snacks

- Please pack your camper(s) a snack. There is no access to a fridge or microwave.
- Please do not pack any food that contains or may contain nuts

● Water Bottle

● Appropriate Clothing and Spare Clothing

- Please wear play-appropriate clothing that can stand to get a little messy. For preschool camps, we recommend sending a spare change of clothes as back-up!
- **Socks** are required. Wonderhub requires all guests to wear socks in our museum exhibits, including camp spaces. Shoes are not permitted unless they are a clean, indoor only pair.

● Prep for the Weather

- During our outdoor exploration time, all campers are expected to head out as a group, and should come prepared for the weather each day. In the colder months, this includes winter boots, ski pants, jacket, mitts, toque, scarf. In the warmer months, this includes a hat, running shoes, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug spray.
- Please apply **sunscreen and bug spray** prior to arriving at camp. If you send extra sunscreen and bug spray with your child, please tell them to ask for help from a leader before reapplying.

● Personal Items

- Campers should not bring any personal items such as toys, cell phones, games, smart watches, or money to camp
- Staff are not responsible for the loss or damage of items brought to camp

● Lost and Found

- Any items found after camp has ended will be placed in Wonderhub's lost and found. This is located in the Gift Shop off of the main lobby and can be accessed during Wonderhub's regular operating hours



Health and Medical Information

- ☀ All campers must be able to use the bathroom independently
- ☀ If a child becomes ill while at camp, they will be moved to a separate space, their belongings and take-home creations will be gathered with them, and a phone call to their parent/guardian will be made requiring immediate pick up from camp.
- ☀ For campers with allergies that require an Epi-Pen, or asthma requiring an inhaler, please ensure this is indicated on your registration form. At drop-off, please indicate to staff where the Epi-Pen or inhaler is located. Epi-pens and inhalers will accompany the campers in the museum and outdoors. Medication must be clearly labelled with the child's first and last name.
- ☀ If your child requires medication, it should be administered prior to camp when possible. If it must be taken during the camp day, please contact us ahead of time to discuss.

Camp Etiquette and Expectations

At Wonderhub, we emphasize being kind to ourselves, others, and the environment, including the museum exhibits. It is important that all our camps, staff, and volunteers feel welcome, safe, and engaged. Wonderhub is a space to come together, celebrate community, and learn through play. We foster a sense of care and respect for others through facilitating safe, positive behaviours, and age-appropriate conflict resolution. Camp leaders strive to lead by example with positive words, actions and reinforcing positive behaviours.

At Wonderhub, we prioritize the safety and well-being of all children, staff, volunteers, and visitors. Unsafe behaviors are those that put anyone at risk of harm. This can include actions such as running away from the group, hiding, using hurtful words or actions towards others, causing deliberate harm to another person, or damaging property, whether it be Wonderhub's or personal belongings. Any unsafe behavior will be addressed and redirected immediately.

If a child's behavior threatens their own safety or the safety of others, Wonderhub may ask the child to go home for the day to ensure everyone's well-being.

In the event that a camper must be removed from camp due to behaviour, you as the parent/guardian are obligated to pick your camper up from camp promptly. Any damage to property will be paid for by the parent/guardian. No refund will be issued for campers asked to leave due to behaviour.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

We understand that sometimes life happens and things come up. Wonderhub can offer a partial refund on camp fees (including before and after care fees) depending on the amount of notice provided before the first day of camp. Fees outlined below are per enrolled camp.

15 days or more

- 100% refund on camp fees, and before and after care fees, minus the following admin fee:
 - Wonder Camps – single-day school year PD Day camps: \$25.00 admin fee
 - Wonder Camps – multi-day school break and summer camps: \$75.00 admin fee
 - Wonder Camps: Mini Discoveries (multi-day half-day summer camps for ages 3-5): \$50.00 admin fee

8 to 14 days

- 50% refund on camp fees and 50% refund on before and after care fees

7 days or less

- No refund on camp fees or before and after care fees
